## HISTORIC COTTAGES SHOWCASED IN 7th ANNUAL CANNON BEACH COTTAGE TOUR

Historic homes in Tolovana Park will open their doors to the public for the 7th Annual Cannon Beach Cottage Tour next Saturday, September 11 from 1 p.m. to 4 p.m.

“To date, due to the generosity of home owners, we have been able to open 61 cottages in Cannon Beach to the public, to offer a unique look at the history of Cannon Beach,” History Center Coordinator Sharon Stewart said. “The cottages tell a story of this very special place, and the Tour recalls a time in the past that people are very interested in.”

This is the second year that the tour has focused on the historic Tolovana area, and eight early vintage beach cottages dating back to the 1920s will be the highlight of the yearly walking tour presented by the Cannon Beach History Center and Museum.

A luncheon and lecture, beginning at noon, will also be hosted at the Tolovana Inn, situated on the site of the old Warren Hotel, one of the first lodging facilities on the Oregon Coast. Dick Frank, former Cannon Beach Library director has planned an exciting presentation, complete with costumes, insider info, and great photos!

A reception at the History Center will follow the tour from 4:30 p.m. to 5:30 p.m., featuring wine, door prizes, and a raffle for this year's wall hanging created by talented fabric artist Jean Williams.
